

Bénédicte Savoy appointed to Advisory Board of Allianz Kulturstiftung

Bénédicte Savoy assumes new role as chair of the advisory board of Allianz Kulturstiftung. The professor of art history takes office on May 1, 2020, following Prof. Dr. Christina Weiss.

Bénédicte Savoy holds the chair for Modern Art History at the Institute of Art History and Historical Urban Studies at the Technische Universität Berlin since 2003. In 2016, she received the Leibniz Prize of the German Research Foundation (DFG). She is a member of the Berlin-Brandenburg Academy of Sciences and Humanities and the German Academy for Language and Literature. In 2016 she was appointed professor at Collège de France in Paris. As of this year she is listed among the Top 10 in the ArtReview Power 100 List.
